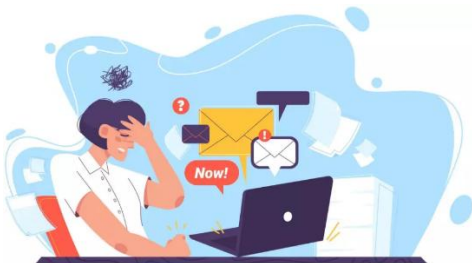

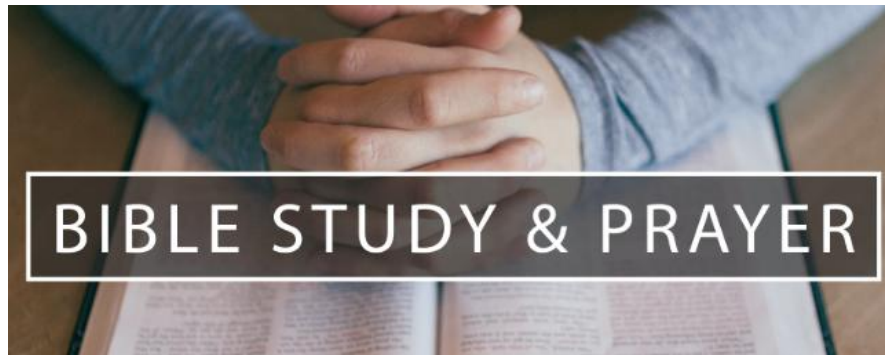

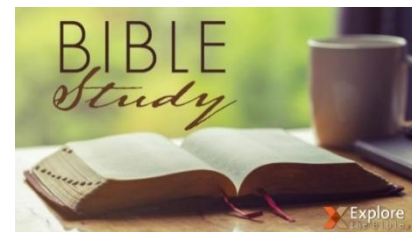
WEDNESDAY EVENING SERVICE
