



Fulfilling pledges is a vital way to support the mission and ministries of St. James. Betsy and I are preparing our Pledge Card this week, just as we have for many years.

As the Chair of the Vestry's Finance Committee, I also want to take this opportunity to thank each of you for your generous pledges and your ongoing fulfillment of those pledges. That allows us to pay the bills and keep the doors open week after week.

Our parish does a great job of meeting pledge commitments. Each year we set our budgets at 5% below the total of all pledges to allow for any unexpected changes. So far in 2025, pledge fulfillment is right on track.

Some people choose to give by placing checks or cash in the offering plate at Sunday services. Others mail checks to the church office or give through their bank's Bill Pay or through PayPal. Some parishioners have given gifts of stock, QCD transfers from retirement accounts, or remembered St. James in their wills.

Whatever your preferred mechanism of giving, it is our Stewardship commitment to this Parish to carefully manage the funds, keeping disciplined budgets and clean audits.

A Quick Guide – Ways to Give at St. James

At St. James, we support several different ways to fulfill your pledge. Whether you prefer giving online, writing checks, giving cash, or making gifts through retirement accounts, there are many ways to give. Please choose the approach that is most convenient for you to continue support for St. James mission throughout the year.



1. In-Person Giving

You can give during Sunday services and other church events by placing checks or cash in the plate when it is passed. If you are give cash and want it counted toward your pledge, be sure to use an envelope labeled with your name, marked 'Pledge".

2. Mail-In Giving

Checks can be mailed directly to the church office: St. James Episcopal Church, 514 14th St., Paso Robles, CA 93446. Please include a note or write <u>Pledge</u> in the memo line of your check. This is a good option if you can't attend in person regularly.

3. Bank Bill Pay

Some parishioners use their bank's bill pay service to set up automatic payments to the church. Simply list St. James as a payee, choose the amount and frequency, and then your bank will mail a check or initiate a direct transfer. This is often a fee-free method for both you and the church.

4. Online Giving through PayPal

PayPal is an online option for you to make either one-time or recurring gifts. The transfer can be through your credit card or bank account. Recurring contributions do require you to start a PayPal account. Go to the website https://saintjamespr.org/ and click the yellow **DONATIONS** button. You may want to top up your donation by 2% to cover the cost of processing fees.


5. Donations of stock or other assets

Gifting appreciated assets like stocks might be a tax-advantaged way to fulfill your pledge. Check with your tax advisor first. Then, if you want to do this, please speak with a member of our Finance Committee who will help with the process.

6. Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCDs)

If you're age 70 1/2 or older, you may wish to make a QCD directly from your IRA. QCDs can count toward your Required Minimum Distribution and may be tax advantaged. Again, check with your tax advisor first. Then let the Church Office know so it will be properly applied in fulfillment of your pledge.

Final Tips: Always include your name and mark your contribution as "Pledge" to help us with accurate record-keeping. For tax purposes, do keep the Quarterly Statements provided by St. James office as your receipts. THANK YOU!


