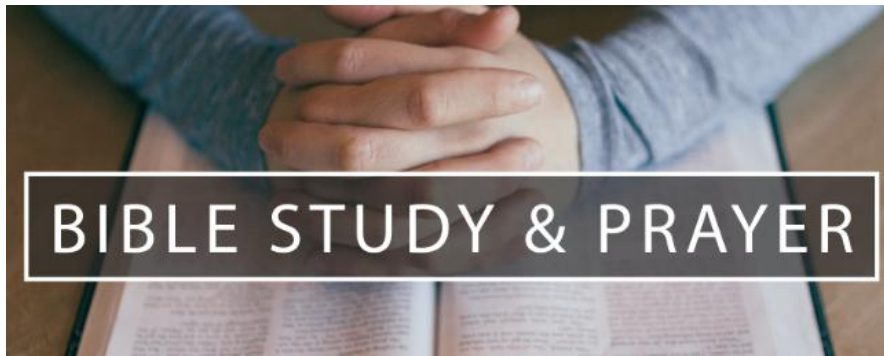

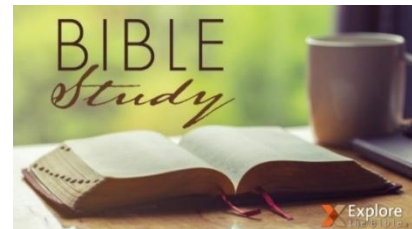
WEDNESDAY EVENING SERVICE
