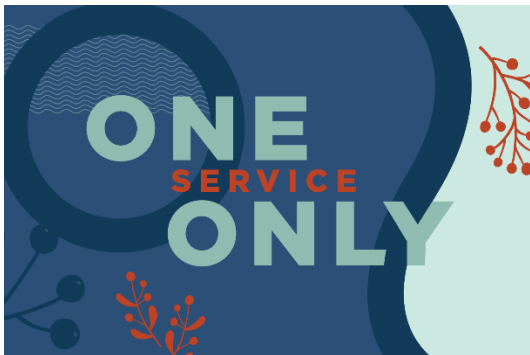

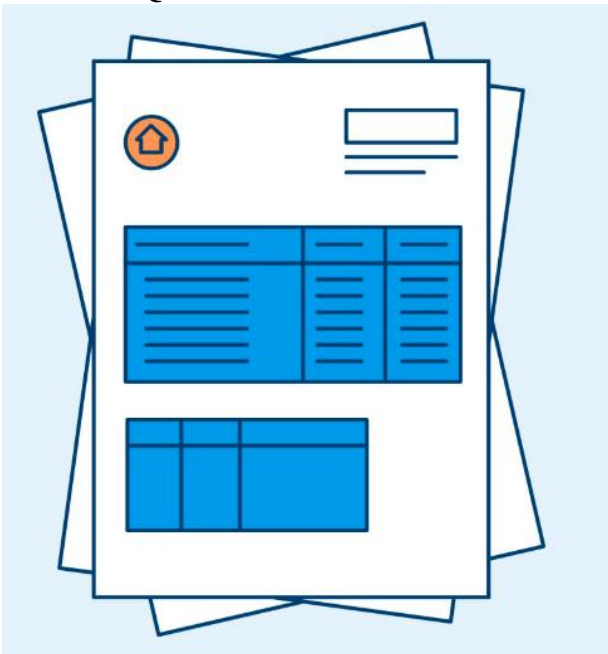

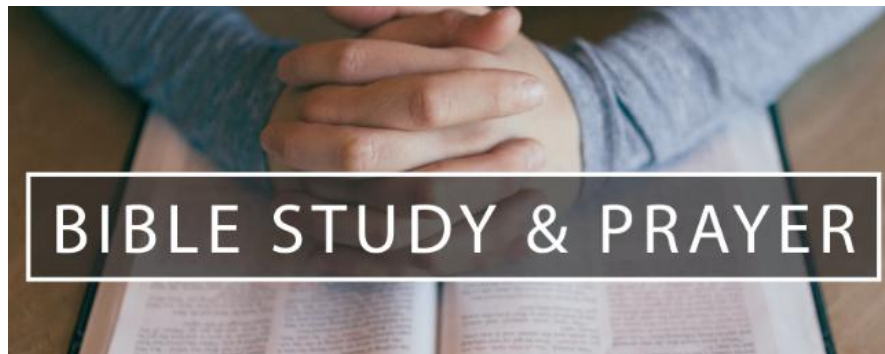
**GIVING MADE SIMPLE:

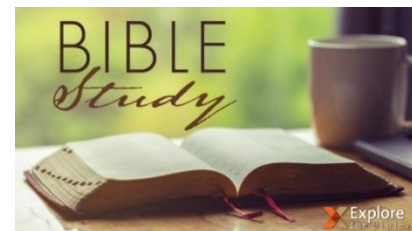
WEDNESDAY EVENING SERVICE
